2025 Queens Community Board Demographic Report

Issued July 1, 2025



Executive Summary

In 2025, Queens Borough President Donovan Richards Jr. continued to build on his administration’s efforts toward rectifying long-standing demographic inequities in community board membership by doubling down on effective reforms and prioritizing appointees from underrepresented constituencies.

Borough President Richards’ initiative to digitize the community board application, launched in 2021, continues to be a major success in generating a deeper and more diverse pool of candidates for appointment to Queens’ 14 community boards. Since 2021, the office has received over 4,500 applications from individuals seeking to serve on their local community board, the vast majority of whom never served before.

In 2025, 916 individuals applied to serve on a community board in Queens. This year, 361 members

were appointed to serve the 2025–2027 term, of whom 119 were new appointees—the largest number of new appointees in a single year during the Richards Administration.

THERE WERE SOME NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS IN THIS YEAR’S CLASS OF NEW APPOINTEES:

- Of the 119 new members, 29.4 percent identify as Hispanic/Latinx—a demographic that has historically been significantly underrepresented across the city’s community boards. Meanwhile, those

identifying as East Asian/Pacific Islander and South Asian collectively comprised 23.5 percent of new members, and African Americans made up 22.7 percent of new appointees.

- Over half—55.5 percent—are under the age of 40, and nearly twenty percent are under the age of 30. The youngest appointee is just 17 years old, reflecting continued growth in interest among young people in community board membership. Prior to the Richards Administration, less than 25 percent of community board members were younger than 45.
- Prior to the Richards Administration, just 43 percent of board members identified as female. But of the 119 new community board members this year, more than 51 percent identify as female. When combining all four of Borough President Richards’ community board application cycles, 52 percent of his new appointees have identified as female.
- Additionally, 24.4 percent of new members are

parents or guardians of a school-aged child, while 19.3 percent are immigrants. In terms of LGBTQIA+ representation, 10.1 percent of new members identified as such, up from 3.2 percent of community board members as of 2020 prior to Borough President Richards taking office.

- Mass transit users make up a significant chunk of the 2025 class of new members as well. More than half of the 119 new appointees (58.8 percent) reported they “mostly” or “often” navigate our borough by using the subway, while 94.1 percent said they at least “sometimes” use the subway to get around. In addition, 92.4 percent of new appointees at least “sometimes” ride the bus, and 42 percent at least “sometimes” use a bicycle or other micro-mobility vehicle for transportation.

The Richards Administration will continue to work toward ensuring that Queens’s 14 community boards are truly reflective of the communities they serve.

Report

Per the requirement of New York City Charter §82(17)(a), the Office of the Queens Borough President (“QBPO”) issues the following report detailing demographic information and the appointment process for Queens community board members.

Queens Borough President Donovan Richards Jr. took office in December 2020 with a goal of ensuring that community boards better reflect the demographics of the communities they represent. The initial version of this report, issued in 2021, identified the major demographic disparities that existed on community boards at the time:



Each board has specific discrepancies, but generally this information demonstrated that Community Boards in Queens are generally older, more male, and less racially diverse than the areas they represent. Specifically, of those who provided information regarding age, only 24.4% of Queens Community Board members in 2020 were 45 years old or younger, while 75.6% were 46 years old or older, and 36.3% were 66 years old or older. Of those who provided information regarding gender, only 43.4% of appointees were women, while 56.6% were men. And although each board catchment area has a different underlying demographic profile with respect to race and ethnicity, members who identified as white were generally overrepresented on boards, and most boards were underrepresented by members identifying as Latinx/Hispanic, Asian, and/or African-American/Black.

Prior to the 2025 appointments, QBPO reviewed the current demographic information for each board’s membership and compared those profiles to the most recent demographic information for each board’s community district. Although prior classes of new appointees during the Richards Administration have lessened many preexisting demographic disparities, some disparities remain.

For this year’s appointments, QBPO employed a strategy it had refined over the prior four years: first, ensure that the community board application process was simple and user-friendly; second, reach a large and diverse group of potential applicants; and third, appoint a new membership class that would help to address identified demographic discrepancies on each board.

First, QBPO continued to employ its online community board membership application, which was introduced in 2021 with the goal of removing unnecessary barriers to applying. Once again QBPO enlisted BetaNYC, a public interest technology not-for-profit organization, to help manage this system to collect demographic data. For the fifth year, the application included questions on a number of additional relevant demographic categories, including (1) whether the applicant owns a home, rents, lives in public housing, or has another housing status, (2) whether the applicant primarily drives, bikes, takes public transportation, or uses other transportation options,



and (3) the member’s educational attainment. After four years of including these questions, QBPO has a much fuller picture of the degree to which each of the borough’s community boards reflect the communities they represent.

Second, QBPO doubled down on its efforts to reach a more diverse and younger applicant pool. Beginning in January 2025, QBPO undertook substantial efforts to publicize the opening of this year’s community board application period. Specific efforts included issuing a press release, posting on various social media platforms and the QBPO website, sending out announcements and reminders in electronic newsletters, and directing staff to share announcements with their professional networks, with a particular focus on constituencies who historically have been underrepresented on the boards. Further, QBPO staff issued announcements at community board meetings held during the application period, as well as at Borough Board and Borough Cabinet meetings and other public meetings and events. QBPO also worked closely with the Queens City Council delegation during the application period and requested that they actively solicit applications from their networks.

This year, not all reapplying members were reappointed; the Borough President declined to reappoint a small number of members, typically due to poor attendance. In total, there were 242 reappointments and 119 new appointments. Vacancies broken down by board are detailed in the following chart.

There were 665 applications in total from those seeking a new appointment. The number of applications for each open spot, disaggregated by board, is provided in the following chart.

After receiving these applications, QBPO carefully evaluated each candidate. The first consideration for appointment to a community board was whether the candidate was eligible for appointment under the provisions of New York City Charter §2800(a). To that end, the online application asked members to affirm that they had a residence, business, professional, or other significant interest in the district. In the case of a claimed “significant interest,” the applicant was required to describe their connection to the district.

If the applicant was eligible, then they were evaluated holistically based on information provided in their application and interview. Like prior years, Borough President Richards sought to ensure that each new applicant was contacted by QBPO staff seeking a one-on-one interview. Interviewers asked questions about the length of the applicant’s residence or interest in the community, whether the applicant has previously attended community board meetings, the applicant’s reasons for seeking appointment to a community board, the applicant’s commitment to consistent attendance at meetings, the applicant’s organizational and community affiliations (as an indication of civic engagement), and the skills and experience possessed by the applicant that could serve the community district.

All community board districts in Queens are made up of more than one City Council district, and QBPO ensured that each City Council district included within

a community board district was as closely as possible proportionately represented on that Community Board, particularly after the City Council redistricting that went into effect at the beginning of 2024. In making final decisions, QBPO considered whether the aggregate of appointments fairly represented all segments of the community, in accordance with the Charter. Prior to making appointments, QBPO met with or solicited the input of each Queens City Council Member. QBPO recommended that Council Members nominate applicants from communities that were underrepresented on their respective boards and, with each Council Member, jointly reviewed a list of applicants from within their Council district, discussed demographic priorities for new appointments, and confirmed which applicants had been nominated by the Council Member.

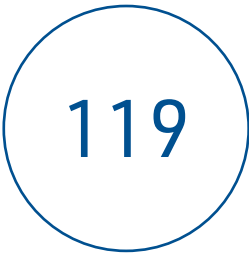
Attached to this report is a list of all Queens community board members as of April 1, 2025, the date on which this year’s community board appointments were made. Queens community board members are appointed for staggered two-year terms that begin annually on April 1. Members whose initial appointment date is 2023 or prior have been continuously reappointed to subsequent two-year terms following their initial appointment. The graphs attached to this report show collected demographic information, presented in an aggregated and anonymized manner, for all members collectively and by board.

Demographic Data of New 2025 Appointees

The demographic data on the 119 new appointees reflects Queens Borough President Richards' ongoing commitment to address demographic disparities on the borough's community boards.

Aggregated and anonymized demographic data for new appointees are included in the graphs below.

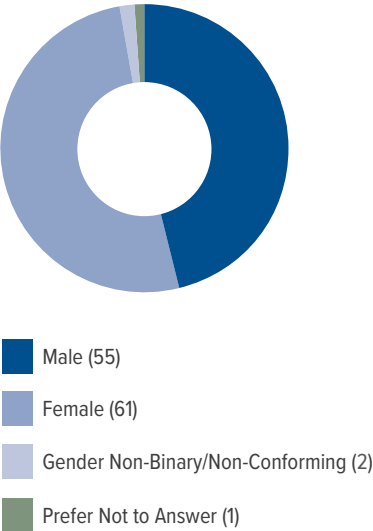
Total Number of New Appointees



Age



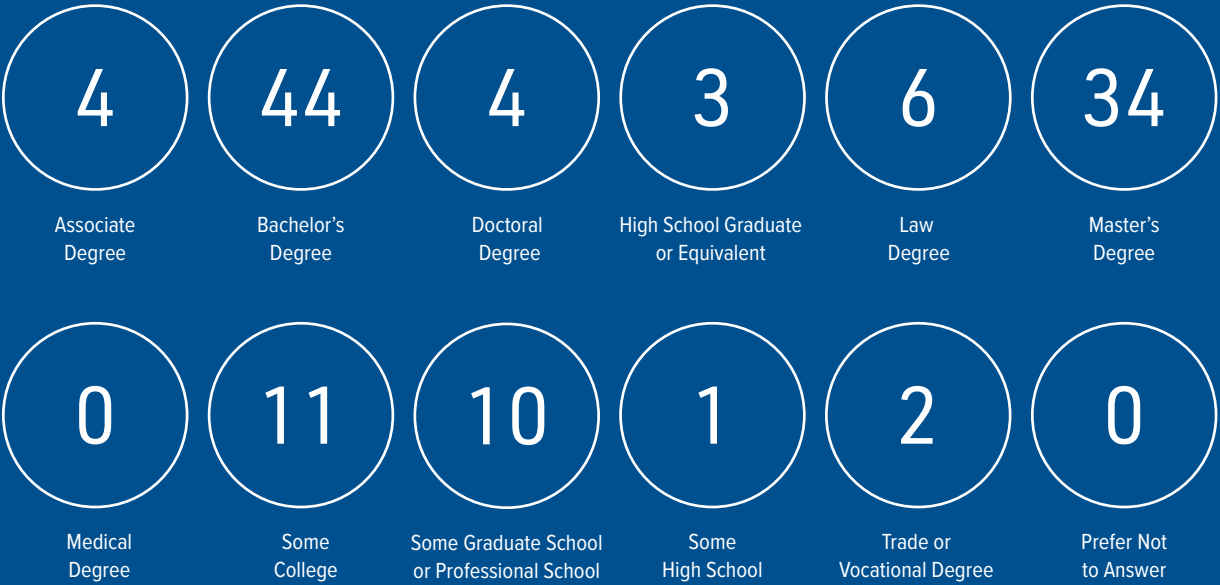

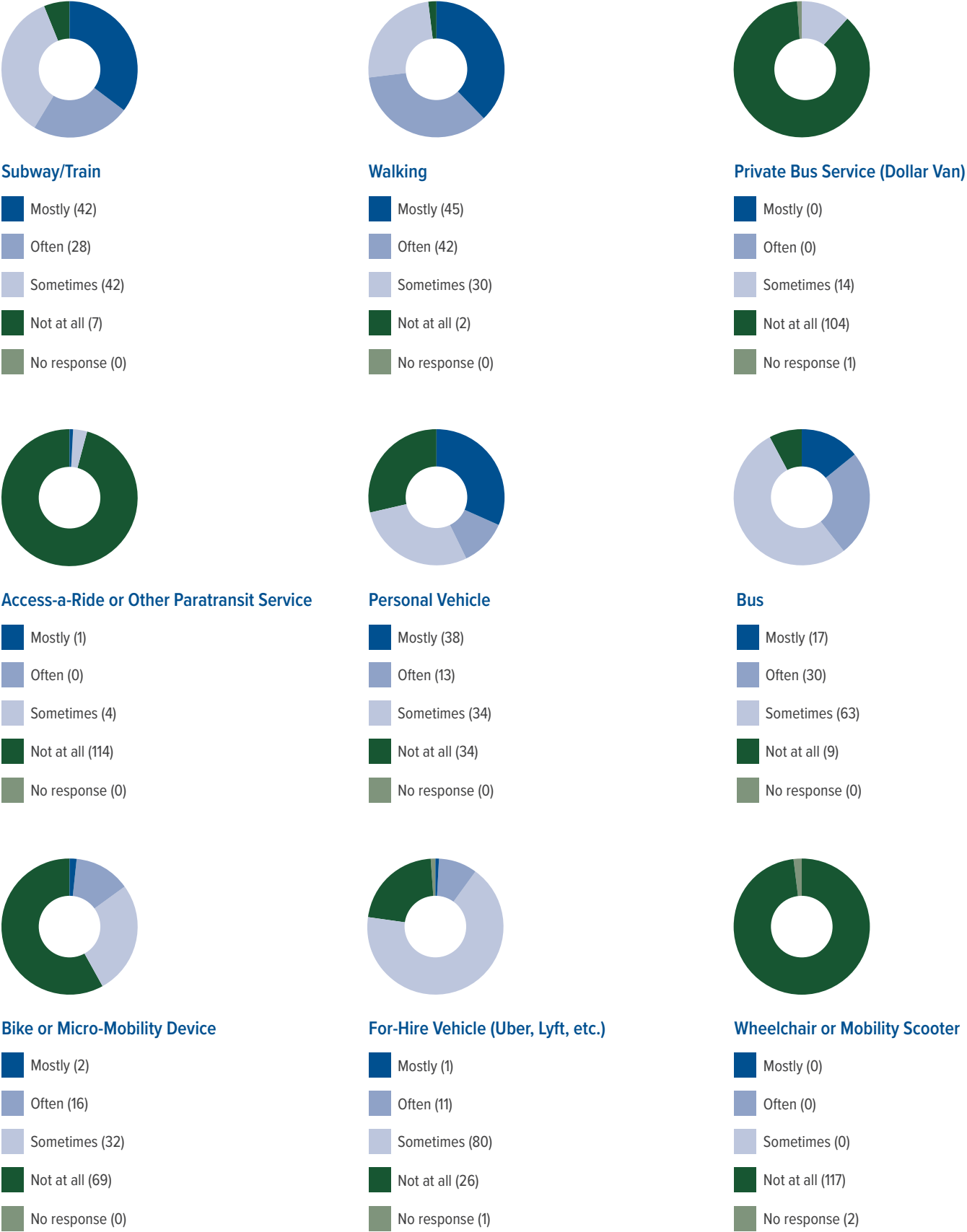
Educational Attainment
